



Best Practices for Media

- Include LGBTQ voices in stories about LGBTQ people and issues
- Elevate expertise over opinion
- Include facts and information from experts and research
- Challenge lawmakers and proponents of legislation to provide evidence
- Include interviews with LGBTQ families and parents
- Include context about the bills' impact on vulnerable populations
- Note how many bills use identical language
- Note ties between LGBTQ extremists and other issue areas

EFFECTIVE FRAMES


Some messaging guidelines

- Always keep the big picture in mind
- Speak to your audience's core values
- Stand for, not just against something
- Have a reasonable tone and contain affirming language
- Break down stereotypes
- Build bridges with audience

INEFFECTIVE FRAMES What not to say

- Telling people how to think
- Repeating opponents' messages
- Speak over the heads of the audience
- Invalidate the audience's feelings by treating opponents, audience, others disrespectfully

If you must respond, use the "Truth Sandwich"

How drag queen story hour became a battle over gender, sexuality and kids

- Drag queens are performers.
- Claims of sexualization have always been levied against the LGBTQ community
- Drag queens are adding to their community and the development of kids by teaching to read.
- Drag is one form of imaginative play, like what we teach kids to do
- Drag queens risk their lives to represent and show up in their communities.

The danger: regression to 20th century laws that dictate what people wear

ANTI-LGBTQ ATTACKS "Grooming"

After 'Don't Say Gay' bill passed, anti-LGBTQ 'grooming' rhetoric surged 400% online

In the weeks following the bill's passage, an average of 6,607 tweets a day used slurs such as "groomer," "pedophile" and "predator" in relation to the LGBTQ community.

Meta has profited from over 200 ads using the anti-LGBTQ "groomer" slur, even though the platform claims it

prohibits the term

Since December, at least 63 new ads using harmful "groomer" rhetoric have run on the company's platforms

Minnesota bill would prevent out-of-state laws from influencing or disrupting children's gender transition procedures

- Every major medical association supports life-saving gender affirming care for health and safety.
- Children and youth transgender care is often just listening, affirming and following up with needs or next steps as the child ages into puberty.
- Anything else is fear mongering and gross inflammatory lies.
 - Trans Refugee Bill Minnesota Rep. Leigh Finke introduced HF146 and said the bill "would make Minnesota into a trans refuge state by protecting trans people, their families and medical practitioners from the legal repercussions of traveling to Minnesota to receive gender-affirming care"

Delegates renew big debate about lines between government and religion

- "Hate speech squelches free speech."
- Free speech means being able to honestly discuss and learn about diverse histories.
- Free speech including condemning words that will cause harm
- Religious freedoms are already protected, LGBTQ rights are not

"People can identify as whatever they want now"

Don't identify as human? North Dakota schools don't want you

A new bill would ban schools in the state from accommodating students who believe they are "any animal species other than human."



- This is perversion of LGBTQ students, who are trying to go to school, hang with their friends, avoid bullying, and be themselves.
- It is an intentional disinformation campaign that has no verified evidence, proof or truth behind it.
- This deflective hoax feeds the anti-equality machine agenda on parental rights in education and anti-trans healthcare bans

Demands
